(Topic: uniform)	• China's school uniforms are mainly sportswear and only a handful of school uniforms have been updated as Western uniforms. For example, Taiwan and Hong Kong school uniforms are usually sailor uniforms or cheongsam.
Young people from both Chinese and Australian cultures often need to wear uniforms in school to	 The colours of Chinese uniforms are often blue, black and red with a small part being white or yellow. Summer school uniforms usually have short-sleeved shirts and in some schools girls' summer uniforms are skirts. In some school, the winter school uniforms are relatively thin and sweaters and other warm clothing can be added underneath the uniforms. Some schools have spring and autumn uniforms. Except on specific occasions, the school generally allows students to freely choose how to match their uniforms.
