Reception - Jolly Phonics

- Follow program as set
- Learn 42 sounds
- Identify sounds in words
- Blend words
- Practise correct formation of letters.
- Introduce tricky words from Week 4.
- Recognise and read 72 tricky words.
- Begin to write tricky words.
- Revise and revisit 42 sounds and blend.
- Introduce take home readers at the beginning of week 4.

Year 1- Jolly Grammar 1

- Follow program daily as set spelling and grammar.
- Read and write 72 tricky words.
- Blend words
- Practise correct letter formation.
- Use word lists as provided.
- Extend word lists for advanced students.
- Revise and consolidate continuously.

Year 2 - Jolly Grammar 2 and Jolly Grammar 1

- Follow program daily as set spelling and grammar.
- Read and write 144 tricky words.
- Blend words
- Practise correct letter formation.
- Use word lists as provided.
- Extend word lists for advanced spellers.
- Revise and consolidate continuously.
