EDUCATION SUB-COMMITTEE

The Magill Education Sub-Committee is a committee that aims to be pro-active in the matters relating to education, particularly those that involve parents and carers at Magill School.

AIMS OF THE EDUCATION SUB-COMMITTEE

- Improve the flow of information between the school and the parent body, in particular to increase parental understanding of the school program and curriculum and what is being taught in the classroom to enable parents to better support their children at home.
- The Education Sub-committee is the main point of contact between school and parents on issues of broad educational policy and parental support for education.

STRUCTURE AND REPORTING

- The Education Sub-Committee meets twice per term on a Monday, before Governing Council's meeting.
- The members consist of Deputy Principal, curriculum coordinators, Governing Council rep/s, and any interested parent / caregivers.
- The committee is facilitated by a Governing Council member in collaboration with Deputy Principal.
- An agenda is set and minutes are taken and emailed to the Principal and to Governing Council members.
