

SCHOOL DRESS CODE

All students are required to wear the correct school dress code at all times.

Exemptions

The Principal may exempt students from the dress code upon written request from parents. Grounds for exemption are:

- Religious, cultural or ethnic
- New or itinerant students
- Financial hardship
- Medical reasons
- Any other grounds as the Governing Council may determine.

Year 7 students

Year 7 students have the option of a senior top and /or a short sleeve polo in addition to the other items listed below. The top is offered once a year and the polo is available all year. This top is optional and is offered in addition to other clothing items listed below.

Shoes

Shoes are as follows for girls and boys:

- Plain brown or white sandals (summer)
- Sneakers – white, neutral, dark colours
- Plain black or brown school shoes
- **NO** thongs, patent leather, suede, platforms or boots (leather ankle boots are acceptable but not basketball boots)

Hats

Magill School follows the Anti-Cancer Foundation's recommendations for maximum sun protection and offers hats in several styles:

- Bottle green legionnaire cap (adjustable)
- Bottle green slouch hat (small, medium or large)
- Bottle green bucket hat

Hats are available from the School Clothing Shop.

Under the Sun Smart Policy, there is a no hat, no play provision during Terms 1 and 4. If you do not wish your child to wear a hat or you wish them to wear a hat other than the school hat offered, you must write to the Principal and inform them of your decision.

Sunglasses, which meet the guidelines for eye protection, are also available.

School Bags

Bottle green school bags with the school logo are required for all students attending Magill.

These can be obtained at the Uniform shop.

Hair and Jewellery

Long hair should be neat and tied back. Ribbons and scrunchies should be in toning school colours.

For safety reasons, jewellery should be kept to a minimum.

Make-up is **NOT** permitted including nail polish.

School Clothing Shop

The School Clothing Shop sells new and second hand school wear. Parents are not obliged to purchase items from the School Clothing Shop. Items can be bought from retail outlets. Parents may be able to make some items at home. All clothing items must be in the school colours of bottle green and gold.
