Chess practice sessions will commence Monday 7th March (Term 1 week 6) and Wednesday 9th March (Term 1 week 6) and will continue until the end of Term 3.

Please ensure that your child is collected by 4.00pm. Children who are not collected on time will have to go to OSHC.

WHO

Students may attend the first week on a trial basis. After this an invoice will be sent home to continuing students. If numbers decline there will only be one night of practice however, this will be determined by the end of Term 1 and parents will be notified.

FEES

There is a fee of \$100 per child and this covers the cost of the professional coach, Vladimir Gajic, as well as interschool competition fees. This covers approximately 27 sessions.

PARENTAL HELP

It is essential that the Magill Chess Program has regular and reliable support from parents to help supervise the after school sessions. Please indicate your availability and a roster will be drawn up. Supervising parents do not need to know anything about chess. The role of the supervising parent is to ensure everyone remains quiet and settled. If we do not get sufficient parental support then practice sessions may be cancelled.

INTERSCHOOL COMPETITIONS

Interschool competitions begin at the beginning of Term 2 and matches occur roughly every two weeks at various venues. They are usually held on Friday afternoons for the less experienced and Friday evenings for the A team. Venues are still to be determined. There is no obligation for children to compete however; they will be asked towards the end of Term 1 if they wish to do so. The coach will then place children wishing to compete in teams.
