## ROUTINE MATTERS



We are now half way through the first term.

Although COVID restrictions have made it more difficult for you to meet with teachers and see classrooms, a lot has happened to set the learning year up in a positive way.

Class and specialist teachers have spent time building connections with students and getting to know them. Students have built friendships with their classmates.

Routines and structures have been established to support a successful learning environment. Families have been provided with the opportunity to meet the teachers and learn about how the class runs and what the expectations are.

All of this work is crucial in setting students up for success for the entire year.

The role you play in supporting what happens at school is a large factor in how successful the school year is.

Helpful home practices include:

- Having morning routines around getting up, eating a good breakfast, getting dressed, ensuring your child has everything they need and arrive with enough time not to be rushed
- Having evening routines which include time with you to debrief the day, time to relax and play, a time and space to do homework, evening meal and regular bedtime pattern
- Good communication with class teachers who are available through apps and email – if you have any concerns, questions or information you think it would be useful for the teacher to know get in touch
- Keeping up to date with what is happening in the school and classroom by reading the newsletter, all school emails and teacher communications
- Ensuring that your child attends school every day unless there is a compelling reason for them not to attend about which the school has been notified

By working together we have the best opportunity to have a year where every child has solid growth in their academic learning and also in their independence and social and emotional development.

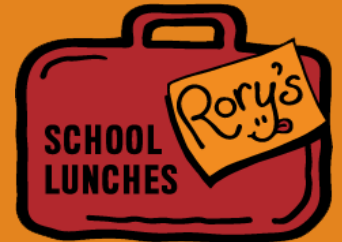


