

# Olympics Unleashed Visit



On Wednesday 11th March, our year 4-6 students were treated to a visit by three time Olympian, dual gold medalist and Order of Australia recipient, Juliet Haslam. Juliet represented Australia in hockey for the Hockeyroos at the 1992, 1996 and 2000 Olympics. As well as being a dual Olympic gold medallist, she won a Commonwealth Games gold medal, two World Cup gold medals, five Champions Trophy gold medals and was named in the Australian Women's 'Team of the Century'.

Magill School was fortunate enough to be a successful applicant with the Australian Olympic Committees' Olympics Unleashed Program. The program takes athletes into Australian classrooms to inspire and motivate students to be their personal best, whether that's in the classroom, the playground, the sporting field or at home.

Juliet's presentation was extremely motivational and shared highlights from her career and life with our students. As a local South Australian and home grown Adelaide girl, Juliet was able to make some wonderful connections with our students and left us all feeling excited and energised in our own personal pursuits and journeys.
