

## SACA PRIMARY SCHOOL CRICKET COMPETITION

	Rules Summary
Year Levels	Year 6/7.
Game Type	30 overs per team, 1 innings each.
Ball	142g hard ball or leather ball.
Timeframe	180 mins, all overs bowled from same end to reduce time. (3 hours)
Protective Equipment	Helmet (including wicket-keeper). Pads. Gloves. Protector (Box).
Boundary	40m measured from batters end stumps.
Pitch Type and Length	Hard wicket – 18m length (tape measure if possible). Measure stump to stump.
Overs Per Team	30 overs per team (180 balls).
Number of Players	9 players per team (max. 9 on field).
Batting	Retire at 24 balls. Retired batters can return when all others have batted, in order they retired.
Bowling	All players to bowl. Max. 6 ball overs (Wides and No Balls not rebowled) 6 players x 3 overs. 3 bowlers x 4 overs. Bowlers to bowl from one end. Bowlers to bowl with a straight arm. Umpires to be fair and consistent when calling No Balls (more than 2 bounces, font foot over the crease or above waist on the full).
Fielding	<ul> <li>Wicket-keeper 2 players x 15 overs each.</li> <li>Rotation of fielders in clockwise direction (can bowl in partnerships as long as each fielding position is experienced).</li> <li>No fielders within 10 metres of batter or each other with the exception of regulation (off side) slips, gully and wicket-keeper.</li> </ul>



Dismissals	All dismissals, once dismissed you are out.
	LBW are allowed if directly in front and no shot offered
	(give 1 warning prior to dismissal).
Minimum Players and	Minimum 6 players per team required to play the game.
Impact	6 player team – every player bowls 5 overs, batting
	retirement is 35 balls.
	7 player team – 5 players bowl 4 overs, 2 players bowl 5
	overs; batting retirement is 32 balls.
	8 player team – 6 players bowl 4 overs, 2 players bowl 3
	overs; batting retirement is 26 balls.
Equipment	2 sets of stumps.
	Bat size recommended size 4 to size 6.
	Boundary markers or cones.
	Portable stumps to be used at bowling end as pitches are
	reduced in length.
Results and Scoring	Team with the highest score at the end of each innings is
	the winner.
