



**Expression of Interest for Instrumental Beginner Lessons in 2019** 

## **Dear Parents**

There will be beginner intake classes for new Instrumental Music Students in 2019.

The Instrumental Music program at Magill School is staffed by teachers employed through DECD Instrumental Music (IM). It is a small group tuition program, which leads toward participation in balanced school music ensembles. Magill is fortunate to have two ensembles - String Orchestra, Concert Band.

Your child has attended an Instrument Music Come & Try session. If they are interested in applying for a String instrument in 2019, this form will need to be returned no later than Friday 30<sup>th</sup> November 2018 as the IM String teachers will be holding an aural test on Wednesday, 7<sup>th</sup> November 2018, that your child will need to attend.

Current Year 3 or Year 4 students in 2018, becoming Year 4 or Year 5 students in 2019 may register an interest to learn the trumpet, trombone, violin, viola or cello

Current Year 4 or Year 5 students in 2018, becoming Year 5 or Year 6 students in 2019 may register an interest to learn the flute, clarinet, saxophone, French horn, euphonium, percussion, classical guitar or double bass

Every endeavour will be made to accommodate all applicants. If there are too many students for places in beginner classes, applicants will be chosen based on music ability, suitability for specific instruments, and the balance of ensembles.

Students learning an instrument privately cannot learn that instrument in a DECD group tuition lesson. However, these students may wish to join the ensemble if there are vacancies that maintain balance, after a meeting with the ensemble director. Please register your information on the bottom of this form.

Students are only permitted to learn one instrument in small group tuition with through the Instrumental Music program at Magill School.

There are a number of Magill School instruments available for hire at a fee of \$140.00 for violins and \$180.00 for all other instruments (excluding Classical Guitar). Most woodwind & brass instruments are hired from private companies at competitive prices. Percussion requires the purchase, not hire, of a practice pad, stand, sticks and a tutor book at a cost of approx. \$90. A drum kit is not necessary straight away. Classical Guitar requires the purchase of a nylon string (not steel string acoustic) classical guitar. Please do not make private hiring arrangements. If purchasing an instrument, please consult with IM teacher.
