The Arts

Term 3 is another exciting term for The Arts, with students from Reception to Year 6 participating in a range of music, drama, media arts and dance experiences designed to develop creativity, confidence and performance skills.

Whole School Arts Events

Students across the school will participate in Footsteps Dance Workshops during Weeks 3–5, with every class attending three sessions to learn and rehearse a dance with specialist instructors.

Our term will conclude with the Performing Arts Assembly on Friday 25th September (Week 10) at 9.00 am (weather permitting). The assembly will feature performances by the Concert Band, Footsteps dancers and our annual Busking for Change fundraiser.

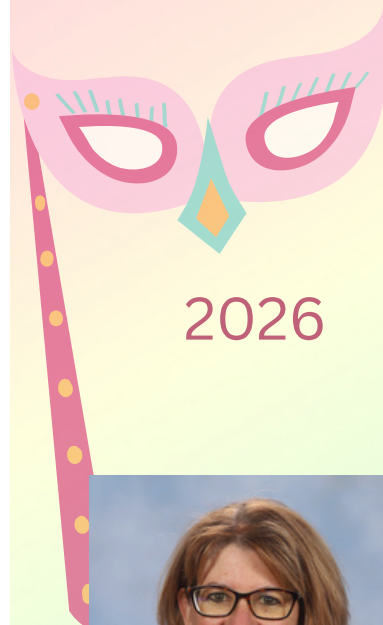
Reception – Year 1

Students will explore the 2026 Book Week theme, "Symphony of Stories", using stories as inspiration for drama activities including script writing, dialogue, role-play and improvisation. In Music, students will learn Book Week songs, create sound stories using tuned and untuned percussion instruments, and continue developing their understanding of beat, rhythm, pitch and tempo through singing and music-making.

Years 2–6

Students will continue developing their musicianship through singing, musical games and performing on tuned and untuned percussion instruments, including xylophones, bucket drums, chime bars and desk bells. Lessons will reinforce beat, rhythm and rhythmic patterns while building confidence in using the voice as an instrument for rehearsal and performance.

In Dance, all students from Reception to Year 6 will explore the elements of dance, including space, locomotor and non-locomotor movement, while learning choreography through the Footsteps program.
